Horse Numbers

Competitors to use NZWRF Permanent Horse Numbers only. No Rider Numbers to be used. All competitors to use NZWRF horse numbers, NO day numbers will be issued so competitors must ensure they have their NZWRF horse numbers.

Refunds

Refunds will only be paid, when a Veterinarian's Certificate or Doctor's Certificate is produced within 7 days of the show.

Ground Rules

The grounds, stables, yards, and wash down bays are to be left clean & tidy. All manure must be removed from yards, stables and all outdoor areas, all hay and rubbish to be picked up and disposed of in the bins provided. To help keep any mess to a minimum please ensure all hay nets are tied to the back of the yards or stables. Do not feed loose hay. Please do not wash manure into the drains of the wash down bays. It just blocks them. Please remove and place in the bins provided.
